## Fillers as an adjuvment treatment for facial dysmorphism

### REPORT SUMMARY



#### PATIENT

A 23-year-old male with severe maxillo-mandibular discrepancy and indication for double jaw surgery presented with poor bone support in the midface and mandibular angles.

#### TREATMENTS

To complement surgical correction, PEG-HA filler (**Neauvia Intense Flux**, 28 mg/ml) was injected: midface (3 boluses/side,

1.5 ml), mandibular angle (0.7 ml bolus), and jawline (1 ml cannula).

#### RESULTS

The filler provided strong projection, enhancing facial symmetry and contour. As a minimally invasive alternative to bone grafts or PSI, Neauvia Intense offers durable results (15–24 months).
